Subject: Concept note and logistics note for the high-level meeting on the prevention of noncommunicable diseases and the promotion of mental health.

Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the high-level meeting on the prevention and control of noncommunicable diseases and the promotion of mental health and well-being under the theme “Equity and integration: transforming lives and livelihoods through leadership and action on noncommunicable diseases and the promotion of mental health and well-being”, to be held on Thursday 25 September 2025, in accordance with to General Assembly resolution 79/273.

In accordance with the resolution, the high-level meeting will consist of an opening segment, a plenary segment, two multi-stakeholder panels in parallel to the plenary segment, and a closing segment. The concept note for the high-level meeting as well as the logistics note are enclosed herewith. The programme of the high-level meeting will be shared in due course.

All Member States, Observers and members of the United Nations specialized agencies are encouraged to participate in the high-level meeting, including the multistakeholder panels, at the highest level possible.

In accordance with resolution 79/273, a list of speakers will be established in accordance with established practices of the General Assembly, and the time limits for these statements will be three minutes for individual delegations and five minutes for statements made on behalf of a group of States. Inscription on the list of speakers for the plenary segment of the high-level meeting will be open on the e-deleGATE portal on Tuesday, 26 August 2025 at 10 a.m., and will close on Thursday, 18 September at 5 p.m. The list of speakers will be circulated prior to the high-level meeting.
